2020 is finally behind us, and it is time to look forward and celebrate the incredible accomplishments of the St. Vincent de Paul Society of Marin during this unprecedented pandemic. This year marks Vinnie's 75th year of service to the most vulnerable among us in Marin. It is our 75<sup>th</sup> Diamond Jubilee – now that is something to celebrate! Please join us on Saturday, October 9th, 2021 for our annual gala, Pennies from Heaven, at the exclusive Meadow Club in Fairfax.

Last year, St. Vincent de Paul Society made quick pivots to continue serving our clients during the pandemic. We served 548 meals per day, seven days a week – that is **200,000 meals last** year for hungry families in Marin, and we did not close our food kitchen a single day!

In 2020, Vinnie's distributed more than **\$1 million** for emergency rental assistance to prevent homelessness, and we assisted **50** homeless people with financial support to "return home" to housing in other areas. In the last five years, SVdP, along with our Marin collaborative, has permanently housed **329** chronically homeless individuals and they are remaining housed at a **94% success rate**, higher than the national average of 85%.

This year, one of our key goals is to end veteran homelessness in Marin. We know we can do this! Together, we are ending hunger, poverty, homelessness, and isolation for struggling children, adults, and seniors in Marin.

With these goals in mind, we look forward to reconnecting with you at our **75<sup>th</sup> Diamond Iubilee** edition of **Pennies from Heaven**. As you peruse our silent auction, enjoy fine wine and spirits tasting, a caviar bar by The Caviar Co., as well as passed hors d'oeuvres. Our gourmet dinner will be paired with award winning Emeritus Wines and Peter Paul Wines. Our carefully curated live auction promises to feature unique experiences, both local and abroad. After dinner, enjoy our fabulous Telford's Cigar & Cognac Lounge and dancing.
